



Dear Westbury Learning Community and Families,

You are truly missed! We are hopeful that you are in good health and in the best spirits under the circumstances. While we can't wait to have you back with us, we remain as vigilant as ever about safeguarding the health and wellness of every student and staff member in our district.

On Friday, August 7, Governor Cuomo announced that all school districts statewide are allowed to reopen flexibly for the 2020-2021 school year based on low infection rates in every region. We are still awaiting further guidance from the New York State Department of Health and New York State Education Department. In preparation, we will be moving the first day of school for our students to further establish safety protocols and prepare our faculty for a different way of teaching and learning. The following is the new schedule for the beginning of school. Your child's building principal will be sending out more detailed information regarding transportation, pick-up and drop-off, classroom configurations, class schedules, policies, procedures and more.

To help simplify this complex plan, Governor Cuomo has also asked all districts to post detailed information regarding testing, contact tracing and how we will be equitably handling remote learning. In addition, we will also be scheduling a series of Question and Answer sessions to address any questions and/or concerns that you may have as we approach the beginning of the school year.
